

DECLARATION – CONFLICT MINERALS

Regulation (UE) 2017/821 (Due Diligence Regulation Minerals)

In response to the violence and the human rights violations following the extraction of certain minerals from the "Conflict Region" located in the eastern part of the Democratic Republic of Congo and the neighbouring countries, Arca Polimeri is committed to supporting the humanitarian goal of ending the violent conflict in those areas.

The term "Conflict Minerals" refers directly to gold, tin, tantalum, and tungsten, materials that are not used in our production processes and are not the object of purchase for our raw materials.

We also exclude the possibility of traces in plastic polymer based on recycled materials.

Despite this, in the spirit of social commitment, Arca Polimeri Srl ensures that it will:

- design and develop products that do not contain conflict "Conflict Minerals.
- not intentionally source materials and components containing the specified metals from mines and smelters in the 'Conflict Region' that are not certified as 'Conflict Free.

For this reason, Arca Polimeri is not obliged to compile any CMRT form and can declare itself a non-responsible importer of these substances.
